Complaint about Parking

This week we received a complaint from a local resident regarding parking. One of the things the resident mentioned was that parents are arriving to pick up children very early – sometimes earlier than 2.30 pm. We realise that some people come early to get a car park space near to the school but it is causing problems for local residents being able to access the car park space outside their own homes.

Starting School in 2018

We would like to remind all parents of children who are due to start in Reception in September 2018, that in order for their child to be allocated a school place they must complete the Local Authority admissions application process. Letters have been sent home to advise you about this process – applications must be completed by 15 January 2018.

Attending a nursery does not mean that children will automatically be admitted to a primary school and that a separate application for a place to start school must be made.

If you have not already done so, could we please ask that you call into the school office with your proof of address, ie Council Tax Bill. Thank you.

e-Safety

May I remind all parents to ensure that “parental controls” are all up to date on any electronic devices that your children have access to. This is particularly relevant if you are thinking of buying new devices for Christmas presents.
