Holy Communion Celebration in School – Tuesday 27 June 2017

On Tuesday the school celebration will take place. Children should come to school in their Communion wear at the usual time and photographs will be taken. For the group photograph and Mass, boys need to wear full school uniform with tie and their sash. Mass will take place and then the children will have a party. The party food will consist of ham or cheese slice sandwiches, crisps, cocktail sausages, sausage rolls, fairy cakes and haribo. Water will be provided (to avoid juice spills on Communion clothes). This food will take the place of school lunch. If your child would not be happy to eat the party food, you are most welcome to send in alternatives. Dinner money for the week will be £8.00. Girls will change into school uniform after the events.

Holy Rosary School App – reminder

We would like to remind all parents about the Holy Rosary App. It is available to download free from either the Apple APP Store or the Google Play Store – simply search **Holy Rosary Aintree**. We'd like to encourage ALL parents to download our school App. As you know, when we send text messages to you there is a cost to the school. If all parents use the App we can stop sending text messages completely and use the money we will save to provide extra resources for your children.

A feature on the App is **Meetings and Events**. We will be able to use this to inform you of meetings and events to which you will be invited, eg class assemblies etc. When you receive an invitation to attend a meeting you will be able to indicate if you are able to attend simply by clicking a button and this will save you having to send a reply slip back to school.

Parents who have already downloaded the App have given us very positive comments.
